Thank you for giving Ski Haus Holidays the opportunity to quote for a tailor made holiday for your MX5 group. I have put together a sample itinerary of what we could offer your group in August 2006. This is a draft itinerary and is open to suggestions from yourself and the group. The figures are based on a minimum group size of 10. Pension Aschenwald can accommodate up to 24 guests in twin/double rooms. Should the size be greater than this we could arrange accommodation at a neighbouring pension.

Example itinerary:

Sunday – Arrival Day

Arriving on Sunday afternoon, having settled into their rooms, guests will be welcomed with a free drink and afternoon nibbles in the bar and dining room. In the evening, a 4-course evening meal will be served at a local restaurant just minutes from Pension Aschenwald. Guests are then free to return to Pension Aschenwald's bar or sample some other establishments in Scheffau.

Monday - Accompanied walking day

Depending on individual's inclination, fitness etc, accompanied walking groups would investigate some of the miles of walking in the Wilder Kaiser mountains. Lunch would be taken in one of the many mountain restaurants and after a shorter afternoon walk, guests could relax at the PanoramaBad swimming complex in Soll. After returning to Pension Aschenwald, guests would meet in the bar, early evening, before returning to Gasthof Weberbauer for their evening meal. Evening drinks will then be taken in the "Biker Bar" in Scheffau.



The swimming pool complex at Soll, 5km from Scheffau. This is an excellent place to finish a good days walk. A local bus takes guests back to Scheffau.

Ellmau, 3km from Scheffau, also has a large pool complex, which is exceptionally good for children.

Tuesday - Excursion day to Salzburg

After a beautiful 1-hour drive through magnificent mountain ranges you arrive at the historic city of Salzburg. The City stands in a breathtaking setting and is rich with magnificent architectural treasures. The influence of Mozart is everywhere with his music dominating festivals and street musicians alike. Visitors may also like to take the “Sound of Music” tour! See the Lonely Planet guide to Austria for ideas on how to spend the day.

Wednesday - Mountain biking day

After breakfast, guests will be accompanied around some of the miles of mountain bike routes in the Ski Welt region. Two groups, dependent on ability, inclination etc will take differing routes, meeting up for lunch at a mountain restaurant. Returning early afternoon for a well-deserved rest, guests will meet in the Pension Aschenwald bar for pre barbeque drinks. At 6.30pm, a barbeque will be served on the patio of Pension Aschenwald.

Thursday – GrossGlocknerStrasse

The GrossGlocknerStrasse is described as “the most spectacular road in Austria”. The road takes visitors on a magical 50km drive, rising up to 2500m above sea level. Leaving after breakfast, guests might wish to visit Kitzbuel, possibly the most famous Austrian resort, before entering the GrossGlocknerStrasse. Lunch can be taken in one of the restaurants beneath the GrossGlockner; Austria’s highest mountain at almost 3800m. After the GrossGlocknerStrasse, a short drive brings guests to Bad Gastein, a town famous for its radon-rich hot springs where travellers have come since the middle ages in search of natural cures. Evening meals can be taken in Bad Gastein or any of the villages en route back to Scheffau.

Friday – Optional Activities

A free day for guests to relax or try out one of the many activities available in the region. These could be pre-arranged if necessary, and could include:

- Balloning
- Sky Diving
- White Water Rafting
- Canoeing
- Canyoning
- Horse Trekking

There are too many golf courses with 20km to list. The nearest, at 2km from Pension Aschenwald, is an 18-hole course in Ellmau, the neighbouring village. Kitzbuhel has two 18-hole courses (about 8 miles)

On this final evening, guests will dine again at Gasthof Weberbauer and return to Pension Aschenwald for a farewell drink

Saturday – departure day

Included in your package:

- Bed and Breakfast for 6 nights. All rooms have en suite facilities, balcony, TV with cable TV decoder, CD Clock radio, and hair dryer.
- Breakfast will be served from 8am to 9.30am and there will be a cooked option, which can be requested on a daily individual basis.
- Rooms will be serviced mid-week, providing fresh linen and towels.
- Welcome drink and nibbles on the afternoon of arrival.
- Evening meals at Gasthof Weberbauer, on your day of arrival, walking day and evening before departure.
- A BBQ will be served at Pension Aschenwald on the mountain biking day.
- Accompanied walking on one day.
- Accompanied mountain biking on one day, including bike hire.

Not included in your package:

- Cost of cable cars
- Entry to swimming pools
- Lunches
- Drinks other than on arrival.
- Optional activities and costs on excursion days
- Entry to the GrossGlocknerStrasse
